When I told him to go back to his room I saw through his eyes like someone totally controlled by his yetzer hara asking for help, he was so ashamed I just feel sad for him.

I am now thinking that he and me are not that different, we both struggle with a hard addiction in different ways, different levels, who knows!

But what I know is that watching myself in his place acting out like that and being caught like that, just gave me a lot of strength and fear of what I'm really facing with this addiction! P.S. My mom talked with this guy mom and she was totally devastated, he obviously has to leave. Just imagined my mother in the same situation for a while, and got a lot of strength to get out of this now with help from G-d!!
