I understand that you are not asking if I may look at porn before davening, rather you are asking what should I do if I fell with porn before I davened. Right?

From your question I can see that you are well aware of the prohibitions of porn and JO. It's just that you have not yet learned how to overcome your struggle.

For me it sounds more like the yetzer hara telling you, you can't go now daven you just saw the worst things and hashem wont even listen to your tifela. Right?

But I think that if you'll listen to him you'll end up porning even more.

So instead start reading the Handbook, try to avoid falls, but if you fell don't let lead to a second one. Instead get up, go daven, go learn, get into contact with people and get out of the isolation.

There is hope, it just requires work.

The Lechevitcher Rebbe (a student of R' Shlomo of Karlin) once went as far as to say that even if a person just killed someone and the knife is still dripping with blood, and he feels unable to stand up and daven Mincha (the afternoon service) with all his strength and heart, then he has not yet tasted from the waters of Chassidus!
