

Florida mother shook baby to death for crying while she played Farmville on Facebook

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. (AP) — A north Florida mother has pleaded guilty to shaking her baby to death after the boy's crying interrupted her game on Facebook.
Alexandra V. Tobias pleaded guilty to second-degree murder Wednesday and remains jailed.
The Florida Times-Union reported that she told investigators she was angered because the boy was crying while she was playing the game FarmVille. The paper also reported that she told investigators she shook the boy, smoked a cigarette to compose herself and then shook him again.
According to WJXT-TV.com, Tobias called 911 and frantically said, "He's only 14 weeks old; he's not breathing.

The TV station also reported that after the 911 call, Tobias told investigators that a dog knocked her baby off the couch and that the baby hit his head and stopped breathing.
