One of GYE goals is to develop special handbooks geared to the Rabbanim and Mashgichim (similar to the current handbooks) that will give them guidance on how to address these issues. I had an hour and 20 minutes talk with Dr. Phillip Rosenthal who will be speaking at the Agudah Midwest convention and mentioning our work. Rav Zweibel asked to talk with him as well about GYE and so I gave him the run-down on what we do - as well as our plans for the future. This was one of the big points I brought up with him, and one of the big concerns of the Agudah today. "How do we educate today's leaders and Mechanchim on how to deal with this plague?"
