The most shocking and amazing thing I heard from the aftermath of the tragedy was the truly open heart of Mr Sasson. He said repeatedly at the levaya of his seven children that the only way it is possible to go on at all, is with complete surrender to G-d.

He was not just talking about his pain. He was talking about the futility of life in general. As the RMCh"L put it: This life holds only a fool's hope, for true satisfaction. And then you die and lose even that. That is exactly what he writes in the hakdoma to Mesilas Yeshorim. And therefore the only cogent response is total surrender to G-d - which is what the rest of the sefer is about. And the RMCh"L writes motives for this that HE HOLDS OF, for three types of people. And the majority of the kosher motives he suggests are not for G-d's sake or honor, but for our own happiness. Amazing.

Thank G-d as an addict, I have a burr under my butt. For if I were not ill, I would fall far below all the normal people. I'd never, ever do these things and get close to my own G-d. No way. It would be too hard, and I am too comfort-seeking. I take my shtraimel off (when I wear one) to the normals who have a real relationship with their *own* G-d and can really *mean* 'Elohai', when they say "Elokai neshoma" and "Elokai netzor", etc. I'm nispo'el.

I only have that because I have no real choice. Not kidding.

Thanks Yechida (whatever your real name is, actually) and have a really good Shabbos...and if u are reading this after it, then have a good motziShabbos!
