[quote="I said this on yesterday's GYE Shemiras Einayim & Chinuch Call]

[i]Shoftim v'shotrim titein lecha b'chol shearecha.[/i]

It is not enough for us to set for ourselves [i]Shoftim[/i] & [i]Shotrim [/i]when we are already outside. By then it is too late!

Reb Chaim Volozhiner (in Sefer Ruach Chaim) has a Tefilla to be davened PRIOR to stepping out the door. [It begins: [i]Hineni holeich b'geo tzalmaves u'makom mesukan....[/i]]

[i]Shoftim v'shotrim titein lecha[b] b'chol shearecha[/b].[/i] = at your doors!

When we are still at the door, BEFORE we step out, into the street. That is when we ought to set for ourselves Shoftim & Shotrim!!!
