Parshas Ki Seitzei:

V'haya b'yom hanchilo ess banav ess asher yiye lo, lo yuchal l'bakeir ess ben h'ahuva al pnei ben has'nuah. (21:16)

V'haya is a loshon of simcha. *B'yom hanchilo ess banav* = the day of death.

If someone looks forward to his death with simcha, he is quite depressed.

*Ess asher yiye **lo*** = whatever tools he may have (to use BY HIMSELF),

lo yuchal l'bakeir ess ben h'ahuva al pnei ben has'nuah = He will still not be able to overpower his simchas hachaim over his depression.

It cannot be done alone!

He MUST be connected to friends!

Arami = The Yezter Hora (Ohr Hachaim Hakodosh)

Alternatively;

Aramy = my haughtiness, my Ego.

Oveid = destroyed

Avi = my striving (a loшон of *Lo yo've Hashem slo'ach lo*).

vayered mitzraymah = and led me down to Mitzraim, the Ervas Ha'aretz

vayagar sham bimsei me'at = even though, initially it was just a small dose of lusting,

vayhi sham l'goy gadol atzum varav = the lust grew & grew. It fed on itself & morphed into a mighty monster!

Vayarei'u osanu hamitzrim vayanunu vayitnu aleinu avoda kasha = Lust made my life unmanageable!

Vanitz'ak el Hashem Elokai avoseinu... = We asked for help from a Higher Power who CAN restore us to sanity...

Parshas Nitzavim:

Sholom yiyeh li ki b`shrirus libi eileich l'maan sfos haravah ess ha'tzmei'ah.

Sholom yiyeh li = I will not fall

ki = when

b`shrirus libi eileich = I fantasize over images that my heart sees (memories & fantasys). {Rashi explains that *Shrirus* means 'seeing'. Like "*Ashirenu v'lo attah*". Hence, *shrirus libi* can be read: What my heart is viewing.}

l'maan sfos haravah ess ha'tzmei'ah = It WILL feed my lust!!
