The following piece was inspired by Uri's good-bye party.

What in the world does Hashem want from me???

The question may bother many of us. [In-fact the more it bothers us the better!]

The Torah tells us that avodas Hashem is not supposed to be all that complicated. It's just about choosing Our creators prescription for life over the option of death.

So why on earth do many of us find ourselves in a situation where we are sure that we don't want to sin - we are absolutely sure that it's self-destructive, and yet we keep doing it.

WHY DID HASHEM PUT ME IN THIS SITUATION - WHAT IN THE WORLD DOES HE WANT FROM ME???

In my humble opinion, the same question can be asked about Klal Yisroel as a whole. The world is so flooded with tumah beyond any description. Znus has become the religion of the world and it's just all over the place. Take Manhattan for example. So many thousands of frum Jews need to be in Manhattan daily, but Manhattan makes S'dom and Amorah look like cities of Tzadikim.

All that is NOTHING-ZILCH-ZERO compared to the Internet. We all know that the Internet is the supreme, ideal, and perfect weapon of the y'h. It's like if AL-qaeda would have a massive nuclear arsenal. BUT the world has become increasingly dependent on the Internet, to the point that "outlawing" it, is not at all doable. We are totally stuck with no way out. [I'm sorry to say that filters are about as much a solution to the problem as a ??''?(fortified room) is a solution to a nuclear attack]

SO WHAT - FOR HEAVENS SAKE- DOES HASHEM WANT FROM US???

I don't see much of a difference between these two questions.

Searching for the answer to this question is -in my opinion- the step 1 of the Torah approach.

The pasuk in Shir Hashirim says:

The midrash explains the moshol as follows. The dove sees a vulture coming after him so he hides between the rocks. The vulture comes closer and so the dove is forced to go under the rock. But down there, there's a big snake! And the dove is totally stuck!

That - says the midrash - was the situation that Hashem put us in to by the Yam Suf. And why? Because He wanted to hear our beautiful voice and He wanted us to show our beautiful true colors.

We live in the Olam Hasheker and our true essence becomes unrecognizable as our *guf* takes over. We become distant from Hashem and lost in the world of materialism.

BUT THEN THE MOMENT OF TRUTH COMES. THE MOMENT OF LOVE. THE MOMENT THAT HASHEM WANTS TO SEE THE REAL YID - THE MOMENT THAT HASHEM WANTS TO CONNECT WITH US.

In Hashems Infinite Unfathomable Wisdom, He saw fit to create us in such a way that our *pnimius* comes out in a moment of desperation like no other time. At that point we realize that Ein oid milvado - all the illusions fall away and our Neshomoh shines forth in all it's beauty. Because deep inside our hearts, all there is is Hashem - as Chazal say ???!? ???????

And then we feel completely dependent on Hashem and we call out to Hashem from the bottom

of our pure heart. And Hashem finds our voice extremely sweet. [Which means that we gain from it in a way that is totally beyond imagination. Because in truth Hashem does not need anything from us at all. Everything is ONLY for our good.]

Klal Yisroel is in the same situation today. We've been in *galus* for a mighty long time. We have of necessity become more of a "society" than the Mamleches Cohanim that we are supposed to be. For many people being frum means followings the excepted norms in our society. This is a very good thing. It has prevented many from getting lost.

But now Hashem is putting us in that desperate and impossible situation where there is simply no escape. Hashem is telling us:

Hashem is telling us: It's time for the real thing; it's time for you to show your true colors. It's for you to shed the "????? ?????" and to be the real you.

It's time to run away from the olam hasheker and return ?? ?' ?????? .

And the exact same is true for each one of us on a personal level. We find ourselves in the grip of taivoh in the most extreme way. *Al pi derech hateva* there's no way out - as the Gemoroh says ?? ???? ???????. But all that taivoh is just ????? ?????? that the y'h "clothed" on to our burning desire for Hashem. Our real desire is buried so deep that perhaps we don't even feel it at all.

BUT THE TIME HAS COME ...

The big difference between us on a personal level and Klal Yisroel on a general level is that we (hopefully-[that's the real step 1]) feel the squeeze; while the "world" doesn't.

That means that Hashem expects us to lead the way. We have to start the revolution and Klal Yisroel will follow. This can help us understand the very extreme chidush that R' Tzodok says (see "Who am I" thread) that those with the strongest connection to taivoh and sin will be the leaders when Moshiach comes. Strange as it may sound we will lead Klal Yisroel out of golus!

Rather ask Him to return you all the way to Him (see Torah Tavlin thread)

I want to add a few points over here:

1) We don't change overnight just by crying our heart out. Hashem wants us to work on changing ourselves consistently, stubbornly and with *yishuv hadas*. We need patience and perseverance. All the mitzvohs -especially Torah and Tefilah, can effect this change if we want them to (see Torah Tavlin thread). Torah and Tefilah when combined together have an even greater power.

2) Shmiras habris is called midas hayesod and it is the foundation that everthing (including -perhaps especially- Torah and Tefilah) stand on. So we need to invest heavily in this area. This is particularly true for us. The Gra and R' Tzadok say that the area in which one finds himself the weakest, is the area that he was sent down to this world to work on and that is what is needed for his tikun. BUT the intention must be, NOT to get this nuicense out of the way, but rather to return completely to Hashem. Being immersed in taivoh is synonomous with being distant from Hashem. **Our intention and our efforts must be concentrated on changing the direction of our desires 180 degrees.**

3) Only Hashem knows how much to squeeze us. Some of us may need to reach a higher level of desperation than others in order to reach the desired effect. Sometimes people ask: Doesn't Hashem know that I can't handle this? Doesn't He know how weak I am? The answer is -of course, that Hashem most definitely knows what we can do; the question is do we know? We have no idea what power our neshomoh has. And we also have no idea what it takes to bring that power to fruition. **Emunah and Bitachon are the only way to go!**
