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If they don't work for you then avoid them. My experience is that the chat rooms aren't any different. You have a big mix of people in the forums and on chat who have a lot of ideas, it may not be the best place for you.

The one-on-one instant chat may be a better choice. You can choose who you want to speak

with. See what guys have a lot of sobriety and start up a conversation with them. Maybe the phone calls will be helpful to you.

I've been meaning to comment about triggers for awhile, so maybe this is a good spot. I'm sure Dov must have something written on the topic here somewhere, so I guess I'll search around for that as well. Dov was talking about the word trigger and how it sounds like the trigger is causing an automatic and forced response in us. If someone trigger's me, am I the bullet? Maybe I'm a gun in the moshel? Either way, someone comes along and pulls a trigger and that causes a fierce unstoppable reaction. Some people may think that's what a trigger means in our context. That person, place, picture, circumstance etc. is causing me to act. If your thinking that, it's totally wrong. No outside factor can cause or require me to do anything. I have a choice as to how I react to a stimulus. In have a choice as to whether or not I allow that stimulus to have power over me. I only lose that power if I make the choice to give it away. My other choice is to give my power away and surrender the thoughts to God (or however I define my Higher Power).
