So it wasn't really a filter and it defeated the purpose of it. Do you have a close friend that you talk to with about this issue or at least a friend that knows about your struggles? I set one of my friends, who I told about my struggle pretty recently, as the new manager of my filter and he's been pretty good at managing it so far. Before it used to be my mom but that didn't really help.

I recommend that you look into the post I linked in my signature, although the post does need some updating. I think the best route for everyone is to not have a browser on their phone at all, unless it's absolutely necessary, and in such a case the covenanteyes browser is the only browser you should use. This is just for mobile devices though, and that's the conclusion I reached after having access to an iphone with a browser for a very long time.
