I am not sure what the tachlis of posting this is, but that's about it for now.

This is where Hilchos Yichud comes in VERY handy. I recommend being l'fnim meshuras hadin in hilchos yichud.

But even with conversations over the phone, an addict whos working toward recovery is still in pain, and therefore is very tempted to fantasize about pretty women he has to deal with daily. I suggest you examine B'emes your motives and perspectives. If you are agreeing to help her because you want that thrill, then you are not doing this for her sake and you will not have the siyata d'shomaya you need to for her sake. Any Hatzlacha could very well be from the kochos hatuma tryting to ruin you and her, and lead to aveira and chilul hashem, chas v'shalom. Even if nothing 'happens", we are enjoined by the torah to be beyond repute - to be Noki L'fnei Adam V'Elokim. People see that you are being too "friendly" with her, and rumors will fly. It might even hurt your marriage beyond repair. At the very least you could run the risk of thinking of her when you are with your own wife.

There have also been situations where a woman was "planted" by a Rabbi's enemies to entice him, secretly record his words, edit the recordings, etc, in order to incriminate him.

My friend, I've learned over time that Hashem has many good sheluchim available. You don't have to take every job on, Hashem can find someone else to help her. This actually may be your test.

But if it's **unavoidable**, I recommend using the torah's guidelines again to help calm the passions more. Why all those halochos for the Esha Yefas Toar? So she'll be demeaned in the man's eyes, and hopefully he won't come to marry her. Here too, how many times have we thought highly of someone attractive, until we find an eirvas davar which turns us off? The Blond Bombshell who's an airhead or has bad or cigarette breath. Etc, you know what i mean. So find something about her you find displeasing, like she has a pimple or a bad middah, or use your imagination and label her in your mind with herpes or a yeast infection, but CREATE A BARRIER by finding SOMETHING to dislike about her. It's better than a cold shower - you'll not want to touch her.
