Here's something I read in the Artscroll nusach Ashkinaz Siddur that I think all of us understand: "What is man if not his soul. And what is his soul if not his deepest longing."

You need to be healed in this deep place. Hashem wants you, deeply, all the way to this deepest place you cry from--B'chol M'odecha. From the atzmus.

If your shame and anguish didn't go so deep, you wouldn't be the holy man that you are, longing with everything you've got, to be free, to be able to quietly heal, and then stand before Him, knowing that by His chesed alone we all stay clean or fall.

When we fall, even when we fall over and over, and we pick ourselves up, and start again, we are proclaiming to G-d, to all the Melachim, to Klal Yisroel, to ourselves and to everyone close to us, and now to all of us on this site, we proclaim where we stand in Hashem's infinite universe. We proclaim that we stand on the side where we, as decent Yiddin, want to be clean, and that we will never stop doing our hishtadlus, because we have accepted that how this struggle of ours turns out is up to HKBH, but that we must do our part, one day at a time.
