I have a android with netspark. It works great. Believe me, i tried. The only problem that i originally had was that the email account that was on the account was my own. It was really easy to just click 'forgot password' get it emailed to me, whereupon i could (would) change the settings to suit my feeling at the moment. The way that i fixed this was by changing the email to someone elses email account. when i once needed to legit change the settings, i clicked 'forgot password' and he gave me the new password that was emailed to him. it costs \$45 a year, with a free trial at the beginning.
