Should he say that since Hashem gave me this test - He must know that I can do it, or perhaps he should say that this test of daving with a minyan is too much for me right now, and instead focus on the One who sent him the "test" and try to figure out what He really wants from him.

?Bichira does not always apply to every situation. Some things may be beyond us. Thats not a free license to act out and enjoy it because "it's too hard not to", but it does mean that if this situation is beyond our control, then we better get on the phone with The One Above, or some other action that can help us, and TRY, but remember that the end result is up to Hashem, not us.

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
