Once you are an addict and you feel you can't stop, the failing is not to desire the sex - that's ancient history - it's not fighting the anxiety.

By the same token for an addict to employ the services of a prostitute is a much smaller averah than if a regular guy does it because the addict is facing a terrifying alternative, which is not to give in. He doesn't really care about the prostitute, he just wants the anxiety to stop.

That's how it seems to me anyway.
