The answer was not slow to follow, as I sat back down on my seat after davening I took a parsha pamphlet that was laying on the table, over there a saw a vort that the Chudushai Harim (today is his yurtzeit) heard from his rebbe The Reb Bunim of Pershuscha ZY"a who said it over from Reb Moshe Leib of Sasiv Zy"a.

In the tochacha the torah tells us that all the punishments come as result of lack of simcha - happiness, ??? ??? ?? ?????? ?? ?????, so many ask the question due to lack of simcha we should experience such punishments?
