This is actually something I'm a little confused about. My Rav very clearly said in his hakdama to the Hilchos Niddah shiurim he gave during SHOAVIVIM that "Mitzvas Onah" as he called it, is an "ikar" of the Jewish home. That's why the pasuk which the gemara uses as a source for being poreish from one's wife during her onah talks about "not being metamei the mishkan".

It seems to me that when all is normal and the intimate relationship between husband and wife is done right it really is an "ikar" of the Jewish home. But for us porn addicts we may need to shift our focus.

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
