It's very common for people to fall right after 90.

Once you feel like you got to your goal, you lose the excitement of being clean. It's a transition from counting days excitedly to enjoying life with the knowledge of being clean humming in the background.

So true, so for me the count goes on. Day 131. After 90 days the fall has been stopped a day at a time. While my record here does not really come close to the effort our Maker has put in to me to help me overcome, from 1972. The next 8 years my efforts being at two health centers that had a lifestyle that encouraged an obedient lifestyle to Torah, then as a Seventh day Adventist. The days of failure were few and far between, yet still very trying to my heart. Then moving to help small groups, still there was many days of victory, yet when I let my guard down, the fall could come fast, and often for short burst. Now that I can accept that every effort to do right and be right is apart of my success, it is better now to daily aim at a lifestyle of continual righteous behavior. Today, there are days triggers could be many, some days I am as a lion nothing can hold me back. Other days I am a mini craft, a small sail boat in a raging storm at sea.

It has been a blessing of 10 hour days for several weeks, thus I was able to pay my \$90 dollar vow to GYE.

Now work has slowed down, and the appointed times give me a few quality day pays with family, what a joy the blessing of the close fellowship of my personal family. It has been 13 years of a growing life of family, a strong motivation to winning control of mind and heart. My queen desires specially honesty, and she is often granted to sees often the motives of my heart. This is a blessing for from youth I hid myself from myself, and sometimes did not want any to know me, for In my youth, I was rejected for being me, or more often lost all I had gained usually on a yearly bases. This Passover time is healing, though the loneliness of group

interaction is still very stressful. My life convictions have moved closer to the Jewish people. Yet often I must be a Joseph among the Egyptian. Yet as I build my knowledge, and my faithfulness to the earth, and to my Maker, I wait for the day when I will not be taken for granted. Often others of the family of Adam take advantage of my kindness, my position of status, my situation, my morals.
