there are a few points that helped me;

1. I read forums and GYE emails regularly.
2. i came to the realization that if I want to stop I need to stop way before the actual acting out, which includes trying not to fantasize and avoiding grey area for instance clips that are not kosher but not bad.
3. to understand this one I need to make some self disclosure. my mother had a hard time expressing love, it resulted in a great thirst for expressed loved physical and verbal, the issue is that my wife has similar challenges to my mother so I still feel a void.

when my wife says she is too tired etc. I feel very down and pain and anger build up and I end up acting out blaming my wife for it. now I decide that I will try to first really understand how difficult it is for my wife to run the fort and how exhausted she really is before I judge her. this helped me tremendously and as a result we had this week a 3 hour conversation about intimate issues [which never happened before] she explained to me that a lot of stuff is against her nature but she will work on it and I told her that I will be more empathic towards her.
