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

A few things. First, I think what Markz is trying to say is that it isn't your wife's responsibility to take care of your "bodily" needs. A woman has a Halacic obligation to be with her husband if she is able, but as my Rebbi said often, "uch und vey

" if you have to pull out your marriage contract to force your wife to do her obligations. And crrainky, the way Chazal put it is a man is supposed to see intimacy as the way to fulfill his obligation to her- he has no obligation to be with her if she's not interested. I can't imagine that your wife would be very turned on if she heard that she isn't fulfilling your "bodily need".

In regard to your Mom, any way you can respectfully ask her to please refrain from criticizing?
