Ella what...you may mean "give finishing shas with the daf yomi" a shot....Oh, that's the problem, and that's the "I guess" and the "shot", here. But why?

It's OK. Meir is right. Maybe the dafim you do will have some important limud for you or your neshomah in them - and **that** is exactly what Hashem wants you to learn now, and no more of the daf yomi at all! Maybe you will be somewhere you need to be becs you are doing the 2 weeks you end up actually only doing of it, before yeshivah, etc come by and wash it away in other limudim - and that place fulfills a big, big tafkid of yours, or of somebody else's...who knows?
