No harm done, though, just save it for a month from now!

In your heart, do you look to any of these powerful folks/things for the salvation of your own adequacy, self-esteem, or comfort? In what ways do you truly put them on a pedestal of power over you? Specifically, how do you see yourself as *needy* when they are around?

Here is a peek at where this is going:

The goal of this stuff is to write up a list of qualities that you naturally seek in your dependence. It will show you what things you really need in your relationship with G-d.

That is huge.

Just write, think, and write.

We end up seeing what we have been dependent on in a Higher Power, and often exactly why our twisted concept of Hashem has not been working for us. We have all been desperate for acting out - even though it was much trouble and cost. We were working so hard for **something** all those years. Once we admit exactly what we were/are **looking for** in the desperate searches for more sex, lust, fantasy, and our other dependencies - how we hoped beyond hope that they would save us - we can now look to Hashem for what we obviously really need.

Make any sense?

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
